Examination

The college conducts three internal examinations in a successive manner during the course. The average of best two will be taken as internal marks. The regularly and monthly assessment for academic and character is monitored and improved for the weak students. Eligibilities for promotion to the higher class depend on the results of examination conducted by the Board of D.Pharm examination, Thiruvananthapuram. The examination fees has to be met by the students as per the instructions in time to time. Also students have to visit the official website of DME, Kerala for daily updates.

Information
